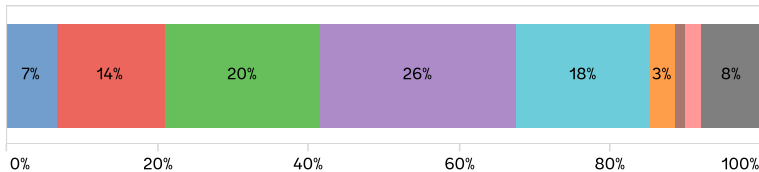

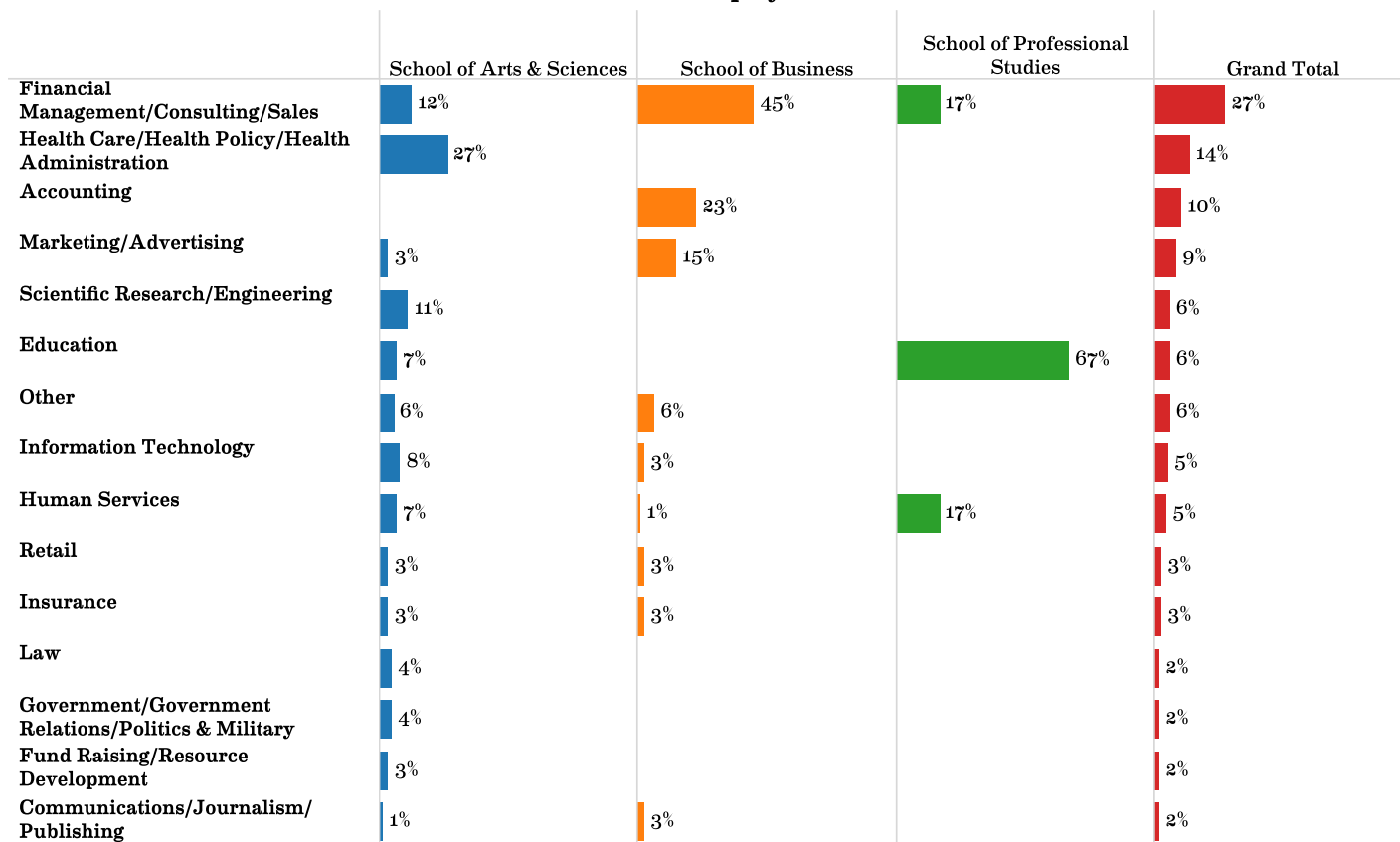

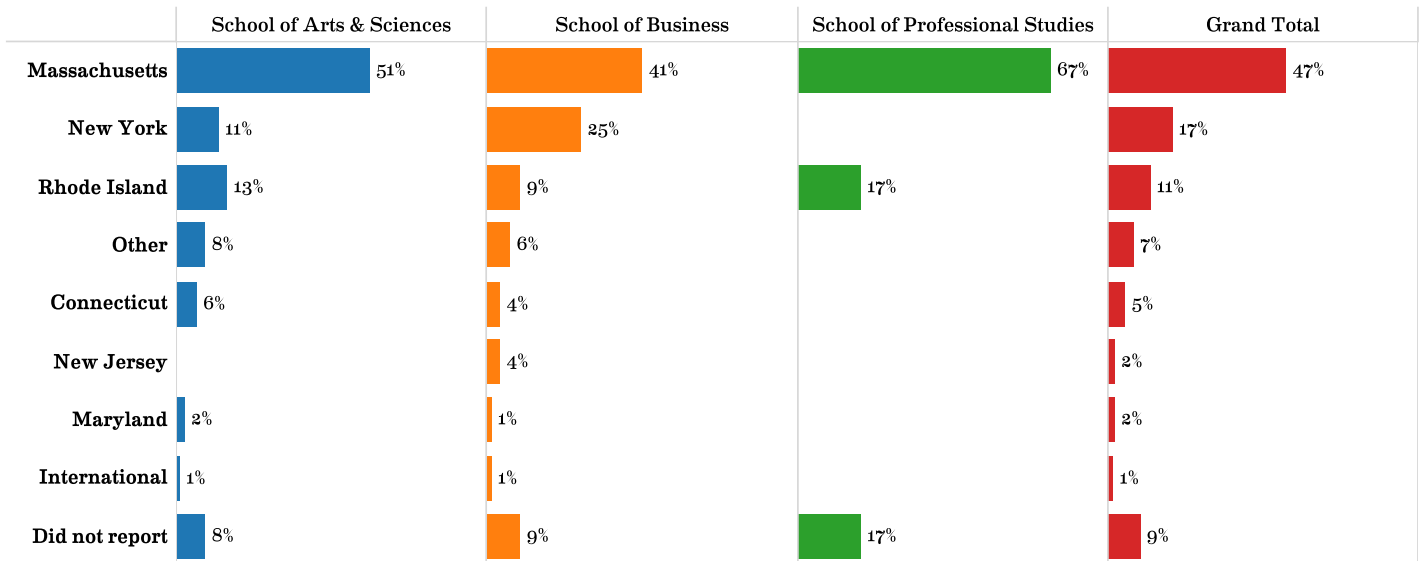

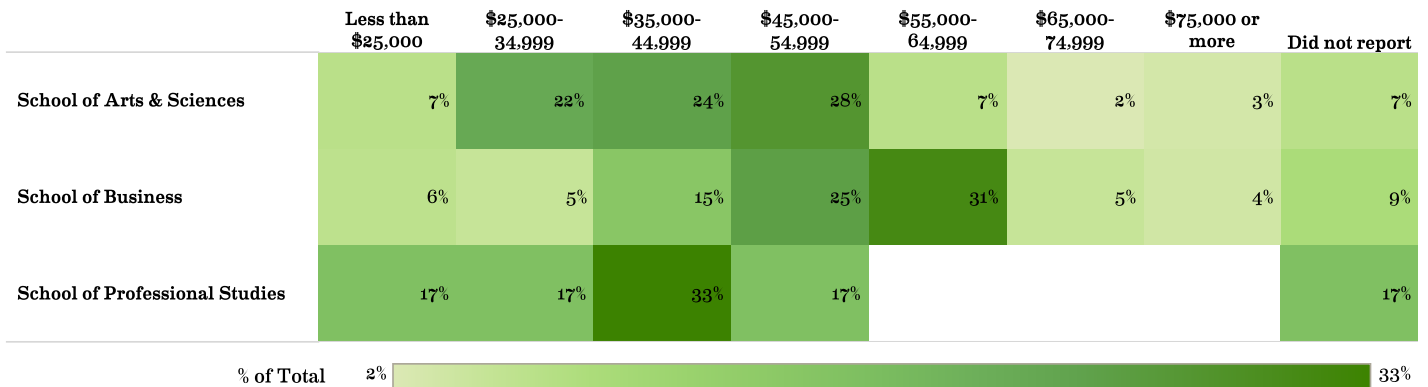


Full-Time Employment Location, Salary (n = 176)
