
Graduate & SCE Career Survey Three-Year Results Summary (GR only) - Classes of 2012, 2013, & 2014


For the Class of 2012, the overall response rate for the survey was 34% (90 valid responses/266 valid e-mail addresses). The response rate among GR graduates was 33% (65 valid responses/198 valid e-mail addresses). For the Class of 2013, the overall response rate for the survey was 29% (79 valid responses/269 valid e-mail addresses). The response rate among GR graduates was 32% (60 valid responses/186 valid e-mail addresses). For the Class of 2014, the overall response rate for the survey was 26% (80 valid responses/305 valid e-mail addresses).

Graduate Respondent Breakdown by Program




For those employed, what is your current employment status?




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Graduate Respondent Breakdown by Program




Are you currently pursuing additional education?
