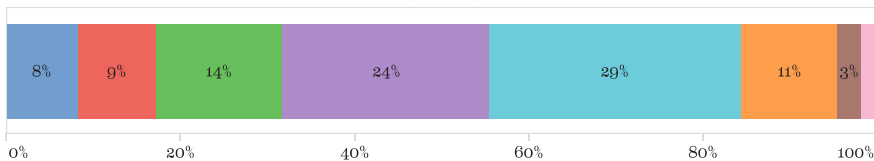

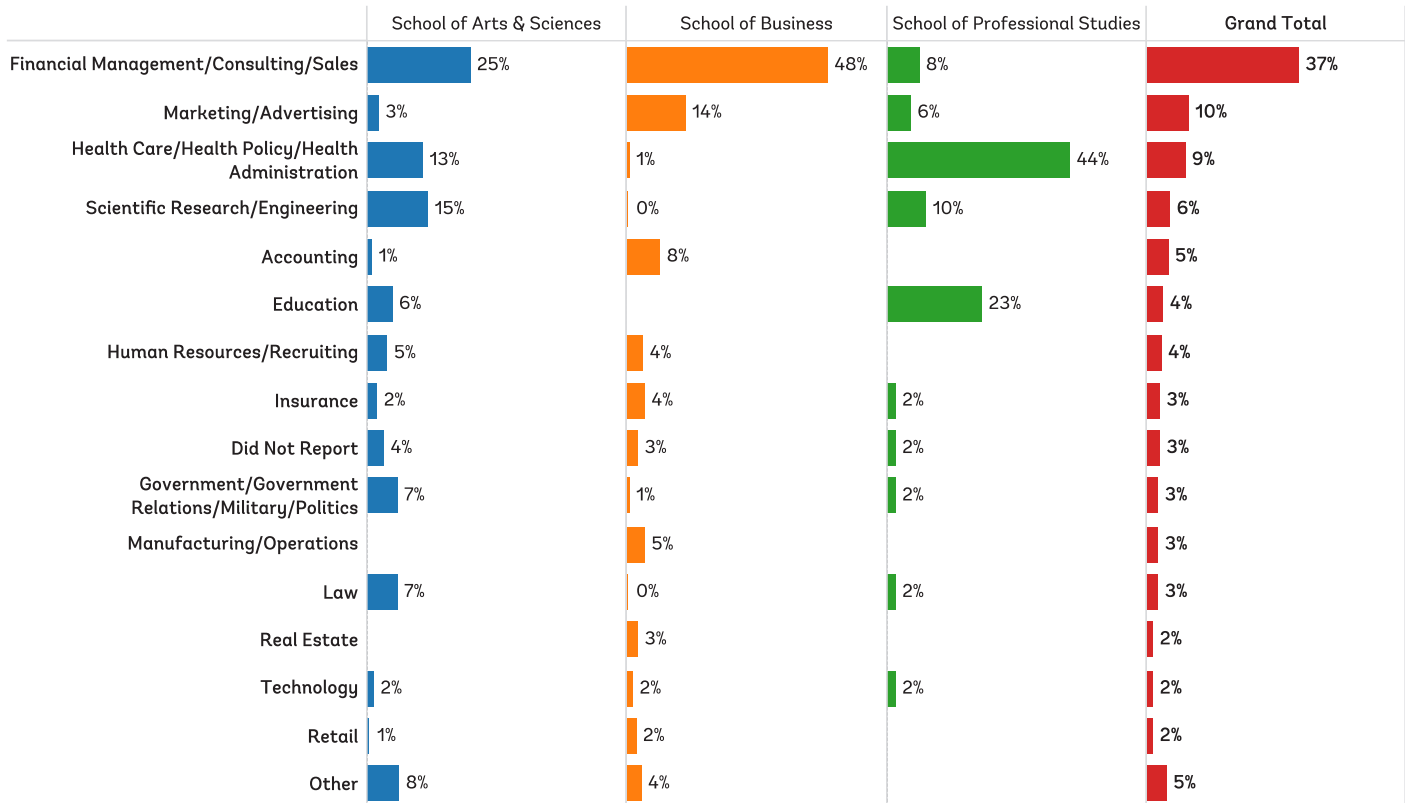

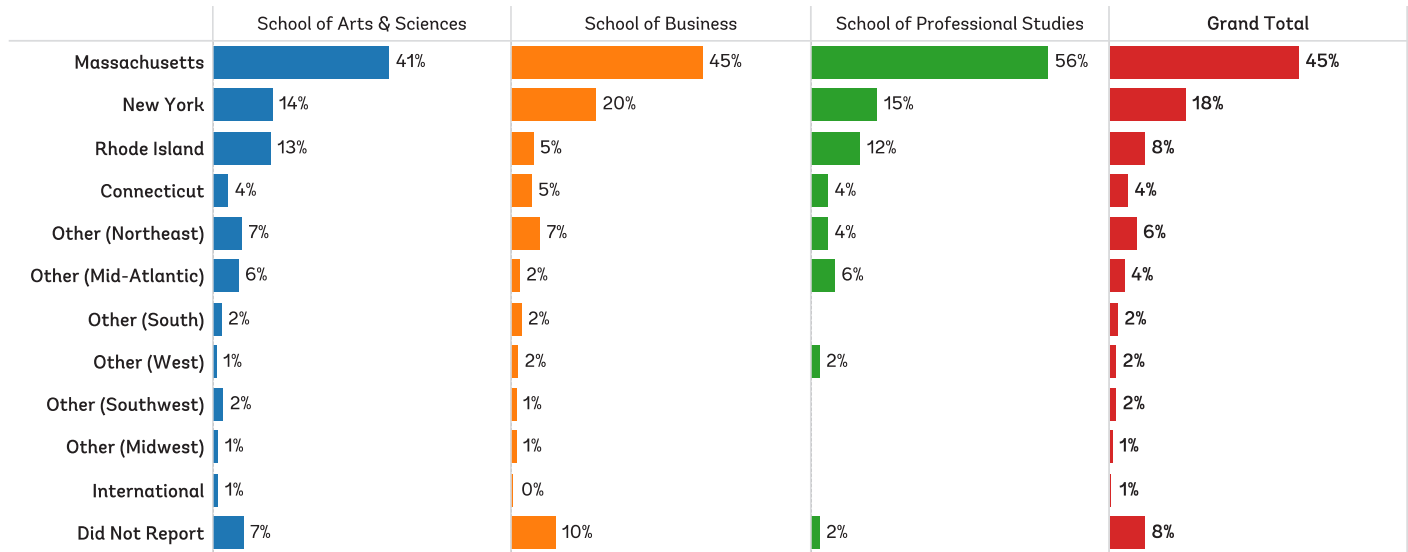

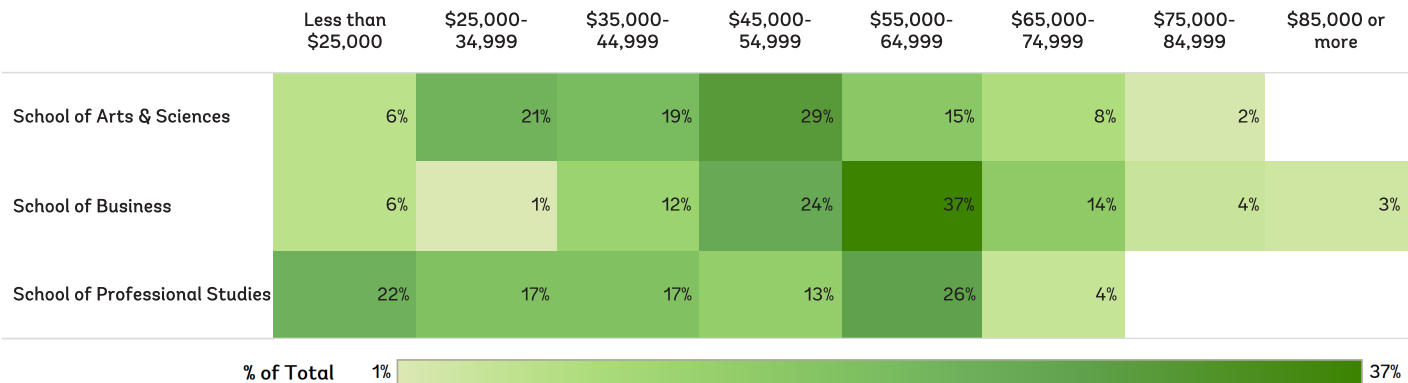


## Full-Time Employment Location, Salary
